

CONNECTION AND TRANSFER RATES RELEVANT TO THE SERVICES PROVIDED THROUGH FIBER OPTIC CABLES (F/O), COPPER CABLES AND RADIO LINK (R/L) RATES EXCLUDING 18%VAT AND 15% SCT

Rate of the connection to be established intended for the service to be provided; consists of 2 rate items related to local access cable and equipment which are chosen from the “Local Access Rates” and “Equipment Rates” tables below. The service being provided doesn’t exceed the local access and equipment capacity which are covered by this connection rate and a Circuit Preparation Fee indicated on the price list per end (Domestic Leased Line, ATM, F/R, Metro Ethernet, G.SHDSL, Point-to-Point ADSL, ISDN PRI (PA)) is being collected for each service provided.

Connection Rate = “Local Access Rate” + “Equipment Rate”

If a new connection is necessary upon transfer requests, the connection rates on this price list are applicable. Circuit Preparation Fee on this price list is being collected per every transfer requested circuit.

Within the scope of this price list, our Company has the right of use and the ownership of the equipment and the cable installed on both user’s and Türk Telekom’s end.

The fees below are being collected along with the current connection price list of the ISDN PRI price list.

***1** No connection fees are being collected except for the circuit preparation fee for the additional circuits requested by the same or another user (by the first user's permission) over the infrastructure set by the user himself within the scope of subscriber investments provided that the current set capacity won't be exceeded.

***2** Where our copper network is not available, the user is being charged **8,77 TL** per every additional meter of copper. The user is being charged for 1 (one) pair of copper cables for all speeds of Point-to-Point ADSL and G.SHDSL services. The user is being charged the fee above for every pair of F/O cables being used for Circuit Connections.

***5** Being collected for each STM – 1, STM – 4, STM – 16, STM -64 capacity. Doesn’t include the equipments to be installed by the user. Passes to the upper level of capacity in case of a user’s request for capacity increase provided that the price difference in between is paid.

If different connection levels or equipment specifications are requested by the user, a pricing study special to that request is being done related to the equipment to be installed by Türk Telekom's and the user's end.

If the SDH equipment to be installed by the user's end can provide 2Mb/s and 34 Mb/s pass levels along with 155 Mb/s as a system feature with a card addition, the SDH fee on the price list is being collected, no additional fees are being collected arising from the card addition.

Furthermore;

1. Provided the permission of the user using the same infrastructure at the same address, in case of another user benefits from the transmission equipment, only circuit preparation fee and additional investment(e.g. fiber connection, equipment) amount (where necessary) as the connection fee until the capacity of the current equipment is full,
2. For the services using fiber cables as infrastructure, satisfying the requests of the users getting service over the retail price list without a connection fee charge if the net income of the commercial districts for 24, 36 or 48 months is covering the connection fee; drawing up a contract for 24, 36 or 48 months; ensuring that the minimum monthly payments shall be done; collecting the entire connection fee amount in case of a contract termination before 24, 36 or 48 months,
3. Collecting performance bond in the amount of total promised minimum monthly payments for the connection fee which is not going to be collected on the contracts to be drawn up with the user,
4. In the event of net income for 24, 36 or 48 months of the areas such as sites, lodging areas, building societies and military bases covers the in-site network investment amount, the investment amount to be covered by our Company under above mentioned conditions with applicable access methods by getting the in-site network into the program under the site administration's permission; collecting the fees in favor of the user for the applications which were previously started but not yet contracted,

5. Net income for 24, 36 or 48 months:

is being counted as

- (a) 20% of the accrual income for the retail price list beneficiaries,**
- (b) Subtracting the contract period and discount rates applied upon the number of terms from 20% for the retail subscribers benefiting from discount.**
